maat is a cognitive behavioral therapy offering evidence based nonpharmacological treatment of

cancer related cognitive impairment crci organized into a session by session clinician manual and related survivor workbook maat is conducted in eight treatment visits and has been demonstrated effective when delivered through telehealth technology the maat clinician manual provides a clearly written summary of the scientific literature on crci and detailed guidance for each visit including an agenda outline in depth discussion and accompanying fidelity checklist in the appendix
